

STATELY RIDES

ENGLAND ON HORSEBACK

TWO DAY COTSWOLD RIDE

From the region of Stow-on-the-Wold to Broadway Approx. 5/6 hours per day in the saddle.

This ride begins near the historic and picturesque market town of Stow-on-the-Wold where you will spend the first night and have dinner with Christopher and Annie Cox in their farmhouse.



Day One

The following day takes you northwards through North Cotswold Hunt country, passing beautiful old beech woods and along ancient valleys. The landscape is hilly and the views magnificent.

Lunch will be prepared by local chef Fleur Sladen in her home in Snowhill village, a quintessential cotswold hamlet.

After lunch you will continue on and down through the Stanway Estate until you arrive at Manor Farm Childswickham home to Marion and Christopher Houghton where you will spend the second night.



Day Two

The morning ride then takes you westwards along the Vale towards Buckland and then up the escarpment from Laverton village. You will then wind down to Stanton where you will lunch at The Mount Inn. A traditional pub perched on the hillside.



After lunch, the ride climbs steeply back up towards Snowhill lavender fields (an amazing sight and smell from July to August) and returns to Condicote passing wonderful houses such as Springhill, and Bourton Hill House arriving at Condicote via the Roman road and finally back to Banks Fee for tea at around 4.30 5.00 pm.

We will of course drive you to the station at Moreton-in-the-Marsh if you have arrived by train.
